BOARD OF DIRECTORS MINUTES

Black Mountain Rotary Board Meeting Minutes for November 1, 2011

Present: Andy Andrews, Roger Hilbert, Meredith Burpeau, Ryan Council, Bill Bauman, Michael Solomonides, and John DeWitt

John DeWitt called the meeting to order at 5:30, as the President was visiting with his daughter and new grandchild. As there was not a quorum present, the meeting continued and all actions will need to be approved at the December meeting.

The treasurer presented her report and all income and expenditures are within budget. Actual income for October was \$1525.04 and expenditures were \$1392.50. The budget report was accepted as submitted.

A request by Bob Watts to be listed under the rule 85 was considered and the board voted to accept the request.

Committee Reports: - J. DeWitt reported that the programs are set through February. Fitz Legerton will be responsible for January and Larry Harris will be responsible for the programs for May. R. Council that membership is continuing to work on new member recruitment and that there has been no significant absenteeism by any member. No reports were received from B.Christy, Gail Jackson, Public Relations, New Generations, or club communications, as members were not present. B. Bauman reported that the club has expressed an interest in hosting the GSE team from Finland and that he has notified district of the club's interest. He is continuing to look into what projects we will support on the international level.

Old Business—The directory is available at the desk and members can pick up a copy at any meeting. The Christmas party will be at the Monte Vista Hotel on December 13, and Richard Hudson is coordinating the event. Also we have heard that the IRS has received our Foundation application and we are now awaiting approval.

New Business—The board appointed a nominations committee consisting of Ron White, Roger Hilbert and Dave Alexander. They will make a recommendation to the board at the December meeting. Roger Hilbert reported on behalf of the Abernathy Award Committee and made recommendations for two individuals to be recognized. The board unanimously approved the recommendations. Andy Andrews was recognized and requested that we have programs available at each meeting for members to read. He was reminded that all the names of members were available at the desk, and that we would print a program with Rotary song and pledge for his table. He also requested that he be able to present the program on June 6th.
